# Summer Activity Calendar

People can walk, skip, and run. Name other words for ways people can move.

What word describes you? Ask a family member to help you look it up in a dictionary. What does this word mean?

Think of a word that describes a family member. Look it up together in a dictionary. What does it mean?

What are the dates for each Wednesday in July? The numbers make a pattern. Add four numbers to the pattern.

Pretend you're a caterpillar. Act out your life cycle!

Talk about sun safety with a family member. Draw a picture that shows how to stay safe in the sun.

Look at this butterfly.



Find a matching butterfly on this page.

Veins carry food and water through a leaf. Look at a leaf. Trace the path the food and water take.

Read a book with someone in your family. Take turns retelling the story. Include as many details as you can.

Look at a calendar. How many months until your birthday? How many weeks?

Make a musical instrument. Place sand or uncooked rice in a paper cup. Tape paper over the top. Shake it while you sing!

Fire + fly = firefly! Can you make three more words that start with fire?

Collect 20 small stones or shells. (Ask a grownup in your family to help you.) How many ways can you sort them?

Use your pebbles or shells to make number sentences. How many ways can you show the number 20?

Look at the words on this page. Can you find two that rhyme with play?

Turn Summer into a tongue twister! Make up a sentence using as many words as you can that start with s.
